Preparing to go to war to defend her empire, Elizabeth struggles to balance royal duties with an unexpected vulnerability in her attraction to Raleigh.

A note from the director, Shekhar Kapur:

"Music for film must not only complement the film but also have its own individuality and it's own story to tell. I was fortunate to have two of the great contemporary composers bringing their immense talents to this score. You could not imagine more different styles and culture. Craig Armstrong, born in a very Catholic environment and trained in classic western compositions, and A R Rahman, a devout Muslim, whose musical talents were honed through the beats of Indian film music and the love of Sufi music. But the music was composed out of a deep respect and appreciation for each other's talents, as one composer searched for his own self in the compositions and the talents of the other."
